Introductions and Study area:-

- To identify and suggest measure for socio-economic problems of the study area.
- To get ourselves acquainted with the people of the society and their culture.

Methodology:-

Secondary data are not much available for this area. Field visits were made to get all first hand information of its physiography, environment and socio- economic. Necessary survey tools like questionnaire, schedule are used in data collection. Data are analysis with the help of statistical tools and methods. Personal interview are made to the villagers to understand their socio-economic problems and status.

Observation:-

- People of the village are economically poor (day labour) and not well educated.
- There is lack of drink water supply. Though there is water supply tank.
- The road of the village is not so well developed.
- There is no good market facilities in the study area.
- There is lots of problem with electricity supply in the study area.
- There is lack of sanitization facilities, cleanliness and modern health facilities in the study area.

Outcome:-

Student were able to interact and understood the socio-economic problem of the study area. The get familiar and leader the survey method by working experience which were thought in their class room. They able to find out that Education, Drinking water, Road and Electricity are the main concern of this village. Administrative and financial support are to be required for initial development of the village. Medical and health services has to be improved.
