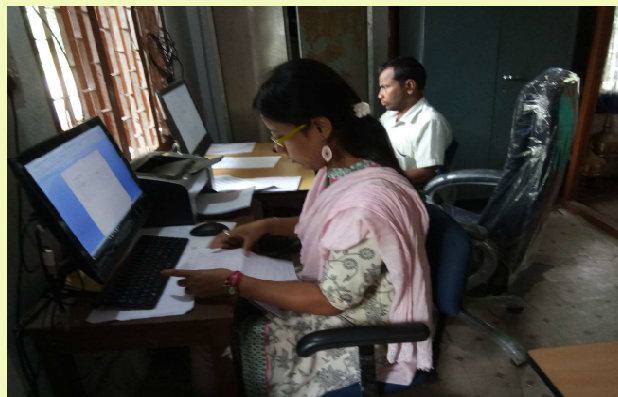

Gogamukh College- a Profile:

Gogamukh College, a pioneer institution for higher education in Dhemaji District was established in the year 1981. It is ideally located between Gogamukh Higher Secondary School and Gogamukh Girls High School, about 1.2 km. away from Gogamukh Chariali. From the very beginning of its functioning the college has been dedicating in imparting teaching activities to its best among students belonging to the most backward ethnic groups that comprising of Gogamukh, Mingmang, Nalbari Bordoibam, Chauldhowa and Bordoloni. The college has been drawn up into the present existence with most determined struggle and selfless dedication of the people of greater Gogamukh.

The Lower Subansiri Project under National Hydro-Electric Power Corporation which is supposed to produce 2000 mw of electricity is 16km away from the college to the northern part. It is the biggest HE project undertaken in India so far and is a run off river scheme on river Subansiri. The project is located in the Assam-Arunachal inter-state border. The estimated annual charge generation from the project is 7421 MU in a 90% dependable year.

The college is situated in the Head Quarter of Mising Autonomous Council, the second largest schedule tribe of Assam. The Council was formed by the Govt. of Assam in 1995 received the assent of the Governor on 27th Oct. 1995.

The objective of the college is to promote higher education in the rural areas inhabited by backward and underdeveloped classes belonging to scheduled tribes, scheduled caste and other backward classes. Through spreading of higher education, evils and superstitions can be credited that are prevailing in the tribal societies. Motto is to bring out a new order in place of old as education is for social reformation. To strive and create business feasibility, establishment of small and medium scale indigenous industries and provide positive role in the socio economic and cultural growth of the locality. The college is a full fledged Degree college in Arts Stream and affiliated to Dibrugarh University and the college has been accorded 2(f) & 12(b) by Dibrugarh University and UGC in the year 1996. The college has attained a position to provide maximum infrastructure facilities in supporting the student societies in acquiring knowledge and skill in a great way. Accordingly the college has acquired its accreditation in the month of Oct. 2004 and was awarded grade 'C'. But in the 2nd cycle of Assessment and Accreditation by NAAC, Bangalore in 2015 (Aug. 2015) the college has been Accredited at 'B' Grade. In the changing scenario of modern education the long cherished dream of the people of Gogamukh as well as the college communities to open a Science stream in the college is initially fulfilled when the Govt. of Assam (HE) accorded N.O.C Vide Letter Memo No. B (2)H407/55(A) Dt. Dispur the 2nd April '05 to the college.

The Dibrugarh University has also accorded University permission to start science stream vide DU letter Memo No. DU/RG/DCDC/GGMC/Perm. Afi/2006-07/2452-58 Dated 28.12.2006. Computer Education, Weaving and Fishery are some of its extended area of teaching. The college authority has already constituted IQAC for monitoring the academic development of the college has a number of cells and committees for students support. The college has UGC recognition under 2(f) and 12 (B). Accordingly the college received non-recurring grant from U.G.C. for its infrastructure development.

Admission procedure:

Admission into the College is made strictly in order of merit, locality and conducted as per by c admission rules and regulations framed from time to time here is a provision for reservation seats for students belonging to ST/SC and other backward class students as per government rules. There is also provision for sports and extracurricular activities quota for admission various courses.

The date of interview for admission into various classes is notified in advance. A list of candidates for admission will be hanged-up on the College Notice Board before the day of Interview. Interview and admission will take place simultaneously on the same day.

The candidate will have to be present personally in the interview with the following documents. Applications for admission into the college should be made along with the prescribed Application Form issues prospectus by the college office on payment of Rs. 150/-

General Rules:

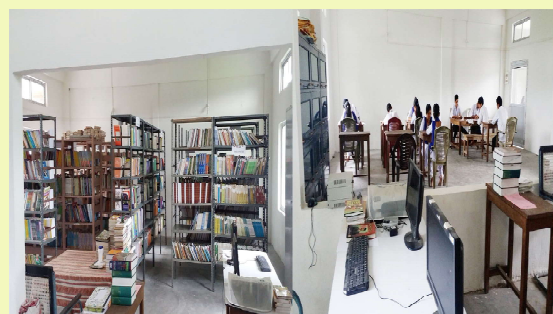
College Library and Library Rules:


